

Annual agreement for the provision of

Sexual Health Services by the School Health Nurse

Oxfordshire School Health Nurses are employed by Oxford Health NHS Foundation Trust and able to provide with the agreement and support of the Head Teacher, a range of services to protect and promote the sexual health of young people, easily accessible on school premises.

The service provided by the School Health Nurse, who will have undertaken specialist training in sexual health, starts with an assessment of the young person's need. Each young person will be assessed for Gillick Competence and contraception provided (if needed) within Fraser Guidelines. All young people are also screened for risk of child sexual exploitation and all safeguarding concerns will be shared with the designated lead for safeguarding in school.

The assessment may develop and cover condom teaching, pregnancy testing, assessment of risk of sexually transmitted diseases with the option of screening and treating Chlamydia, with the provision of Emergency Hormonal Contraceptives if required. If in the young person's best interest, contraception is required, condoms, contraceptive pills, patches or injections can be issued. Sexual health advice and the follow up of students are integral to this process.

The service provided to students is **confidential** and the School Health Nurse will maintain confidential health records on individual students, these will be held on an electronic password protected system managed by Oxford Health NHS Foundation Trust.

Safeguarding - The school health nurse will alert the school's safeguarding lead and/or contact parents and/or the MASH team as appropriate for all students under the age of 13 years, or those over the age of 13 who are not considered to be Gillick competent, who seek sexual health advice or support.

Information on the how the sexual health service is used by students will be fed back annually to school, summarising activity in this area, without identifying individuals.
